HILDERS LANE, EDENBRIDGE

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Hilders Lane, Edenbridge will be closed to through traffic, on or after 15th August 2022 for up to 3 days.

The road will be closed at Main Road to Little Browns Lane.

The alternative route is via Hilders Lane, Main Road, Hole Lane, Monks Lane, Grants Lane, Honey Pot Lane.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 09:00 hrs and 17:00 hrs each day.

This closure is necessary to enable carriageway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.

It will be necessary to close Hilders Lane, Edenbridge from 15th August 2022 for up to 3 days.

The road will be closed at Main Road to Little Browns Lane.

The alternative route is via Hilders Lane, Main Road, Hole Lane, Monks Lane, Grants Lane, Honey-pot Lane.

It is planned that the road will be closed between 09:00 hrs and 17:00 hrs each day.

This is to enable carriageway patching to be carried out by Kent County Council.
