## **Condition of plots**

I recently visited the allotment gardens, and it was wonderful to see so many fine examples of allotments with a fantastic range of vegetables, fruits and flowers.

The Forge Croft Allotments is a tranquil setting in the beautiful Green Belt of Edenbridge providing a really special place for keen gardeners aided by your wonderful skills and contributions.

However, I was also disappointed that there are a small few who have taken to putting other items in the areas that border the paths. For example, old carpets, children's potty, broken chairs, shopping basket, plastic bags and more. I appreciate that this may not be you, but it is such a shame that there are small pockets of areas with debris. I hope this generic letter will serve as a gentle reminder to those who may have temporarily deposited non allotment garden stuff to make appropriate arrangements to clear the area(s).

As a reminder, the condition of your plot and surround is your responsibility. Under the 'site rules' issued to all allotment tenancy holders it says:

3. *Each tenant will maintain their plot(s) in line with the terms of the Agreement, and shall be responsible for the paths surrounding their plot which will be kept mown and edged; all such paths are to be three feet wide and roadways ten feet wide,*
4. *No rubbish will be deposited anywhere on the site, except in any places specially set aside for this purpose, if any, by the Council. Tenants should compost unwanted plant material as much as possible. Bonfires are not permitted on site, with exception of arisings from EAGA's seasonal voluntary perimeter maintenance in the autumn/winter.*
