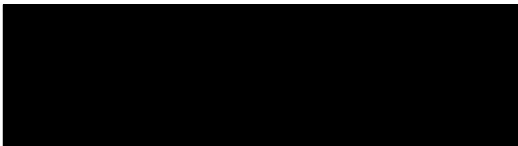
Both these shelters are important learning aids for school visits and we have for some time been on the look out of a Bell shelter such as the one in your yard for the museum.
